MOTION:

To remove Rules 7.2 and 7.14 from the Union's Rulebook because these provisions are no longer compatible with the proposed regional election, representation and vacancy arrangements.

Rule 7.2

The Executive Central Committee shall be elected by the Annual meeting. Such committees shall serve for three years.

Rule 7.14

Should a vacancy occur during the Executive Central Committee's term of office as a result of resignation, expulsion or otherwise, the Executive Central Committee would then have the right to co-opt a member to serve on the Executive Central Committee. That member will be scrutinized by the Executive Board.

Rationale

Rules 7.2 and 7.14 are proposed for deletion because they are no longer compatible with the Union's proposed regional governance and election arrangements.

Rule 7.2 provides for the Executive Central Committee as a whole to be elected by the Annual Meeting. Under the proposed structure, the ECC will instead consist of Executive Board members and representatives elected through the relevant regional arrangements.

Rule 7.14 permits the ECC to fill vacancies by co-option. Under the proposed regional structure, elected regional positions and the resulting ECC representation should be filled through the relevant democratic election process rather than by co-option.

Removing these provisions will prevent conflict between the existing Rulebook and the proposed regional governance structure.
